➤ Criminal deports that have been ordered removed by an IJ (via a Final Order of Removal) that are exiting the United States the same day they board the ICE Air aircraft, are required to have been submitted to ICE Air on a I-216 AND have received confirmation from ICE Air Scheduling of the removal.
➤ Change of venue cases from one DHS institution to another DHS institution must provide ICE Air with the receiving institutions approval with this I-216.

Did you guys confirm if family was in fact paroled? Its my understanding that family presented themselves at the port of entry on December 16 and they were remanded to your custody without parole. I don't think they've ever been to court. I asked OFO to check their records to see if family has ever been paroled for MPP court. I'm starting to doubt that they were even ever paroled at all because there is no record on the government attorney notes for the December 5th court date. I'm also having to doubt that the IJ order is valid and may possibly be issued in error as NTAs May have never been filed. Knowing whether or not family was paroled or when they were paroled will be critical when drafting the NTA especially if BP is moving on an assumption that family was paroled. The question I posed ICE OPLA here in El Paso was asking if family should be considered applicants for admission. The OPLA chief is out and I will have to follow-up with him on the question when he gets back. Do you know if you will be referring these cases to us for release or is BP direct releasing?

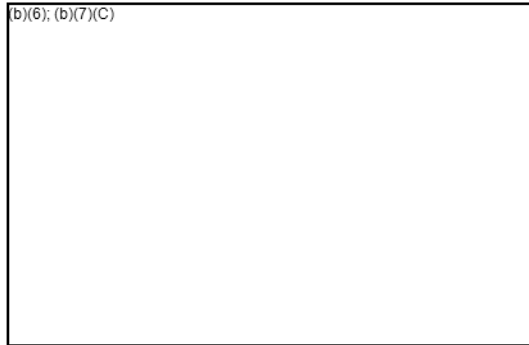

Purpose

This memorandum serves as continued guidance for all personnel assigned to the Criminal Alien Program (CAP) to ensure proper compliance with manual and electronic CAP statistical reporting requirements. A CAP case is defined as any removable alien identified in a Federal, state and local jail or prison, *regardless* of the status of conviction.

ICE Detention and Removal Operations assumed responsibility for the CAP on June 1st, 2007. In order to effectively track CAP cases, the following reporting procedures have been established and are to be implemented immediately.

The nine-core tracking and reporting metrics of the CAP are:

1. Identification/notification of foreign-born inmates
2. Inmate Screenings
3. Detainer lodged
4. Charging Document Issued (CDIs)
5. Transferred to ICE custody
6. Case status (EOIR/IJ hearing status)
7. CAP case outcome (Final Orders, STIPS, Appeal, POCR/OSUP-BOND, Relief/Benefit Granted, Prosecution, Removal/VR, etc.)
8. Removed from the United States
9. Criminal Prosecution presented/accepted

Procedures

Manual CAP Reporting Requirements

All Field Offices will submit the Manual CAP Report in Excel format by 12:00 PM EST every Monday following the previous reporting week (a reporting week is Saturday to Friday) via the HQ CAP mailbox. All line items must be populated with the appropriate data. The report will include 4 individual prison/jail category tabs as follows:
