Additional I-216 Instructions:

➤ Note: Ten (10) copies of an I-216 shall accompany all transfers on ICE Air and an I-770 shall accompany all juveniles.
➤ All aliens required by policy must be IDENTED and stated so on the completed I-216 (with FINS # & Subject ID), including instances when:
➤ Criminal deports that have been ordered removed by an IJ (via a Final Order of Removal) that are exiting the United States the same day they board the ICE Air aircraft, are required to have been submitted to ICE Air on a I-216 AND have received confirmation from ICE Air Scheduling of the removal.
➤ Change of venue cases from one DHS institution to another DHS institution must provide ICE Air with the receiving institutions approval with this I-216.
➤ Aliens going into an ICE / DRO facility for the staging of an international repatriation mission. (The I-77 number needs to be noted on the I-216).
➤ All detainees property is limited to 1 approved bag not to exceed 40 lbs.

Special Cases:

VIOLENT CASES:

Advance notification to ICE Air should be provided via the I-216 and other supplemental information

MEDICAL / PSYCH CASES:

The I-216 shall include the pertinent supplemental information if the alien requires special medical care, special custody precautions, and/or has other issues that must be addressed prior to or during their transportation. (If the I-216 does not provide sufficient room provide a supplement document or information in an Email)

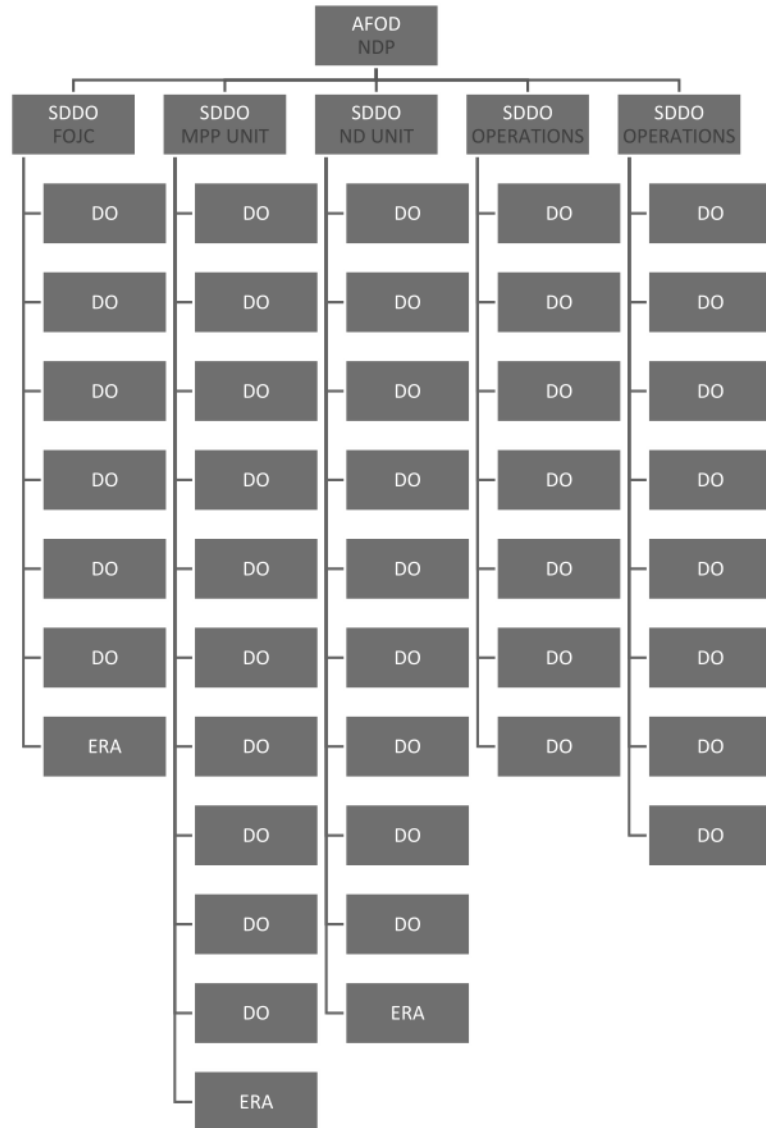

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The ERO El Paso Field Office Non-Detained Program (NDP) serves as a centralized coordination point to facilitate the processing, transport, and transfer of aliens arrested by DHS entities into ERO custody. The Work Plan provides a planning process needed to successfully manage the non-detained dockets and to efficiently coordinate custodial transfer of aliens from CBP to ERO custody.

I. Situation:

This document will outline the NDP duties, work structure, current assignments, and staffing levels as it pertains to the NDP. This Work Plan does not change Field Office Juvenile Coordinator (FOJC) processes. FOJC Unit will continue with its normal local operating procedures.

II. Mission:

In a humanely and orderly manner execute ICE national priorities while ensuring the safety and wellbeing of individuals apprehended by DHS entities and placed into ERO custody for transfer, removal, or release into the United States.

III. Execution:

Director's Intent. It is the intent of the Field Office Director to support all phases of the NDP and synthesize operations with participants to leverage resources. The activation, coordination and acceleration of this Work Plan is at the discretion of the Field Office Director.

General Concept. ERO will facilitate the transfer, removal, or release of alien family groups, single adults, and unaccompanied alien children while maintaining steady state operations.

IV. Non-Detained Program Duties:

In accordance with its programmatic oversight, the NDP oversees the following mission responsibilities:

- A. Docket Management of Non-Detained Cases
- B. FOJC

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- C. Single Adults (Denied ERO Detention)
- D. Family Units
- E. Vulnerable/Special Populations (Denied ERO Detention)
- F. Alternatives to Detention
- G. Non-Detained Walk-ins/Check-ins/Removal Appointments
- H. Immigration Bond Management
- I. Other DHS Programs/Initiatives

V. Other DHS Programs/Initiatives:

The NDP currently supports the following DHS Programs/Initiatives:

- A. Migrant Protection Protocols (MPP)
- B. Prompt Asylum Claim Review (PACR)
- C. Humanitarian Asylum Review Process (HARP)

VI. Non-Detained Program Key Components and Staffing:

- A. Non-Detained Program (1 AFOD)
- B. Non-Detained Unit and HARP Initiative (1 SDDO, 9 DOs, 1 ERA)
- C. MPP Unit and PACR Initiative (1 SDDO, 10 DOs, 1 ERA)
- D. Operations Unit (2 SDDOs, 15 DOs)
- E. FOJC Unit (1 SDDO, 6 DOs, 1 ERA)

VII. Roles and Responsibilities of the Non-Detained Unit and HARP Initiative:

- A. DO manages the Non-Detained Unit mailbox at (b)(7)(E) or to the global email address book as EPC-Non-Detained_Unit Mailbox. DO generates email correspondence, notifications, tallies, manifest, records, and reports for Non-Detained Unit/HARP cases.
- B. DO manages the EN000-EN999 non-detained dockets in accordance with ERO policy and procedure.
- C. DO manages the HARP cases in accordance with ERO policy and local procedures.
- D. DO will conduct case reviews to monitor non-detained/HARP cases for changes/updates or the results of a credible fear determination, removal proceedings, or reporting requirements.
- E. DO manages reporting of non-detained aliens.
- F. DO reviews processing disposition, criminal history checks, sponsorship and residing address are reviewed thoroughly to determine if the non-detained/HARP family unit or individual is a suitable candidate for transfer, removal, or release.
- G. DO ensures release plans and paperwork generated for service are completed accurately and timely.
- H. DO ensures that all data input into (b)(7)(E) is in compliance with HQ Data Integrity Policy.

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- I. DO uses ATD when appropriate.
- J. DO takes action and completes the appropriate forms when bond conditions change.
- K. DO takes action and completes the appropriate forms when custody conditions change.
- L. DO will review non-detained/HARP cases to identify appropriate placement.
- M. DO will review final order case referrals to determine removal via ENV or ERO Detention. Removal coordination may entail utilizing land transport, commercial air, or ICE Air Operations.
- N. DO retains responsibility for travel document requests, case management, and resolution of any issues that may arise until completion of the transfer, removal, or release.
- O. DO communicates with local stakeholders, public, and ERO field offices.
- P. DO communicates with Consulate Officers as necessary.
- Q. DO prepares and routes files to the appropriate office, individual or DCO.
- R. DO reviews and transfers cases in (b)(7)(E) to the appropriate office, individual or DCO.
- S. DO will process and refer non-detained/HARP cases to the appropriate unit/program for placement, transfer, removal, or release.
- T. DO will close non-detained/HARP cases in (b)(7)(E) and ensure compliance with the ERO case closure policy.
- U. DO will assist with operational duties when necessary.

VIII. Roles and Responsibilities of the MPP Unit and PACR Initiative:

- A. DO manages the MPP Unit mailbox at (b)(7)(E) or to the global email address book as MPP-MAIL-BOX Mailbox. DO generates email correspondence, notifications, tallies, manifest, records, and reports for MPP Unit/PACR cases.
- B. DO manages the MPP Unit/PACR dockets in accordance with ERO policy and procedure.
- C. DO will conduct case reviews to monitor MPP cases for changes/updates or the results of an immigration hearing.
- D. DO will conduct case reviews to monitor PACR cases for changes/updates or the results of a credible fear determination.
- E. For those PACR cases in which the IJ overrules the asylum officer's negative credible fear determination, DO will be required to issue and serve a NTA to place the PACR individual into removal proceedings.

IX. Roles and Responsibilities of the NDP Operations Unit:

- B. DO is the point of contact for all alien placement requests (Non-Detained, MPP, PACR, HARP) and generates email correspondence, notifications, records, and the DHS Encounter Report.
- C. DO ensures referrals are on the daily Tally Reports for transfer, removal, or release.
- D. DO conducts electronic case review to ensure that referrals meet criteria for ERO acceptance.
- E. DO promptly forwards emails to docket officers for non-detained, MPP, PACR, and HARP transfers, removals or releases avoiding unnecessary delays.
- F. DO ensures all required reports are submitted timely.
- G. DO will review case referrals to determine removal via ENV or ERO Detention. Removal coordination may entail utilizing land transport, commercial air, or ICE Air Operations.

- X. DO ensures that all data input into the (b)(7)(E) is in compliance with HQ Data Integrity Policy.

X. ERA Responsibilities

- A. ERA provides clerical and administrative support to the NDP staff.
- B. ERA prepares and routes files to the appropriate office, individual or DCO.
- C. ERA routes any received documents to the appropriate A/T file.
- D. ERA updates (b)(7)(E) as necessary.
- E. ERA collects files and file inserts for proper distribution.
- F. ERA updates the EPC unassigned docket and assigns cases to the appropriate dockets.

XI. Roles and Responsibilities of SDDO for MPP Unit and PACR Initiative:

- A. SDDO manages the MPP Unit and PACR initiative in accordance to ERO policy and local procedures.
- B. SDDO manages the MPP Unit mailbox for alien placement requests or referrals.
- C. SDDO ensures that MPP Unit email correspondence, notifications, tallies, record keeping, and reports are submitted accurately and timely.

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- D. SDDO conducts case review to ensure that referrals are appropriately assigned to the MPP Unit.
- E. SDDO supervises the MPP Unit and PACR dockets to ensure that CBP referrals are processed accurately and timely.

- L. SDDO provides guidance on MPP Unit and PACR issues and the applicability of HQ policies.
- M. SDDO provides guidance to staff (i.e. (b)(7)(E) Processing, Audits, ATD, etc.) as needed.
- N. SDDO supervises data integrity in ERO systems.
- O. SDDO communicates with local stakeholders, public, and ERO field offices.
- P. SDDO ensures files are being routed to the appropriate office, individual or DCO.
- Q. SDDO will assign MPP Unit and PACR staff to assist with processing transfers, removals, or releases when needed.

XII. Roles and Responsibilities of SDDO for Non-Detained Unit and HARP Initiative:

- A. SDDO manages the Non-Detained Unit and HARP initiative in accordance to ERO policy and local procedures.
- B. SDDO manages the Non-Detained Unit mailbox for alien placement requests or referrals.
- C. SDDO ensures that Non-Detained Unit email correspondence, notifications, tallies, record keeping, and reports are submitted accurately and timely.
- D. SDDO conducts case review to ensure that referrals are appropriately assigned to the Non-Detained Unit.
- E. SDDO supervises the Non-Detained Unit and HARP dockets to ensure that CBP referrals are processed accurately and timely.
- F. SDDO ensures that docket officers have completed file review for legal sufficiency prior to transfer, removal, or release.
- G. SDDO authorizes transfers, removals or release and signs off on the OREC/OSUP paperwork.

- J. SDDO serve as a liaison between ICE and CBP and other stakeholders to address issues or specific concerns with regards to Non-Detained Unit and HARP initiative.
- K. SDDO provides guidance on Non-Detained Unit/HARP issues and the applicability of HQ policies.
- L. SDDO provides guidance to staff (i.e. (b)(7)(E) Processing, Audits, ATD, etc.) as needed.
- M. SDDO supervises data integrity in ERO systems.
- N. SDDO communicates with local stakeholders, public, and ERO field offices.
- O. SDDO ensures files are being routed to the appropriate office, individual or DCO.
- P. SDDO will assign Non-Detained Unit and HARP staff to assist with processing transfers, removals, or releases when needed.

XIII. Roles and Responsibilities of SDDO for Operations Unit:

- A. SDDO manages NDP Operations to ensure the program adheres to HQ policy and local procedures.
- B. SDDO manages the ERO El Paso NDP Operations mailbox and the Family Unit mailbox for alien placement requests or referrals.
- C. SDDO ensures that email correspondence, notifications, tallies, record keeping, and reports are submitted accurately and timely.
- D. SDDO supervises staff assigned to NDP Operations.
- E. SDDO serves as a liaison between ICE and CBP and other stakeholders to address issues or specific concerns with regards to NDP Operations.
- F. SDDO serves as the principal staff member for the AFOD regarding NDP Operations.
- G. SDDO provides guidance on alien transfers, removals, or releases.
- H. SDDO supervises NDP operations to ensure that all release plans and paperwork generated for service are completed accurately and timely.
- I. SDDO provides oversight and guidance to staff or (b)(7)(E)
- J. SDDO ensures transportation requirements have been coordinated with ERO transportation contractors.
- K. SDDO ensures placement for releases have been coordinated with NGOs.
- L. SDDO coordinates staff assignments and schedules with AFOD.
- M. SDDO assists with operational planning or situational synopsis of NDP operations.
- N. SDDO supervises processing to ensure that all case files, charging documents, release paperwork, criminal history checks, sponsorship and residing address are reviewed thoroughly to determine if the individual is a suitable candidate for transfer, removal, or release.
- O. SDDO ensures that processing staff have completed file reviews for legal sufficiency prior to release.
- P. SDDO authorizes release and signs off on the OREC/OSUP paperwork.

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- Q.** SDDO supervises and provides guidance for the intake and release of individuals.
- R.** SDDO provides guidance to staff (i.e. (b)(7)(E) Processing, ATD, etc.) as needed.
- S.** SDDO supervises data integrity in ERO systems.
- T.** SDDO will assign operational staff to assist with processing transfers, removals, or releases when needed.

XIV. Shift Schedules/Tours of Duty/Assignments

- A.** Appointments to receive individuals will be scheduled daily, Sunday-Saturday at 12PM. Shifts will be set to 6AM to 2PM; 12PM to 8PM.
- B.** Docket officers and ERAs are permanently staffed five (5) days a week (Monday-Friday) to manage their designated non-detained dockets. Officers will be on a rotating schedule as duty officers to manage their designated unit's mailbox and respond to emergent requests for transfer, removal, or release.
- C.** NDP Operations Unit will be permanently staffed seven (7) days a week on two (2) shifts to coordinate transfers, removals, or releases on the following assignments:
 - NDP Intake/Placement Coordinator
 - FRC Placement Specialist
 - Operations

XV. Work Plan for NDP Operations

A. NDP Intake/Placement Coordinator

NDP Intake/Placement Coordinator will manage the NDP Operations Mailbox and be the primary point of contact for all referrals to the NDP. All NDP intake and placement requests shall be referred via email to ERO El Paso NDP Operations at (b)(7)(E) or to the global email address book as ELP Non-Detained Program Operations Mailbox. NDP Intake/Placement Coordinator will conduct initial case review and determine if referral is eligible for acceptance. If accepted, NDP Intake/Placement Coordinator will schedule appointments and refer cases to the appropriate MPP Unit or Non-Detained Unit mailbox for processing. NDP Intake/Placement Coordinator will update the DHS intake report and collect manifests from the Non-Detained/MPP Units for the daily releases. NDP Intake/Placement Coordinator will secure transportation and placement coordination with NGOs for the noon appointments. NDP reports will be collected and consolidated for daily submission to the AFOD. The NDP Intake/Placement Coordinator will be the collection point for manifests and release packets for daily service for the Operational Unit. NDP Intake/Placement Coordinator will refer correspondence and release appointments to the following NDP Units for processing:

- Correspondence and release appointments for the Non-Detained Unit/HARP initiative will be referred via email at (b)(7)(E) or to the global email address book as EPC-Non-Detained_Unit Mailbox
- Correspondence and release appointments for the MPP Unit and PACR initiative will be referred via email at (b)(7)(E) or to the global email address book as MPP-MAIL-BOX Mailbox.

B. Non-Detained/MPP Unit Duty Officers

Non-Detained/MPP Unit duty officers will manage the Non-Detained and MPP Unit mailboxes and be the primary points of contact for referrals to their respective units. Non-Detained/MPP Unit duty officers will conduct initial case review and determine if referral is eligible for acceptance to their unit. If accepted, Non-Detained/MPP Unit duty officers will forward correspondence to docket officers for docket management and processing. Non-Detained/MPP Unit duty officers will update their daily Tally Reports and collect release/removal packets from docket officers for the daily releases or removals. Non-Detained/MPP Unit duty officers will create manifests and deliver both the manifest and release/removal packets to the NDP Intake/Placement Coordinator for coordination with stakeholders. Daily Tally Reports will be submitted to the NDP Intake/Placement Coordinator for consolidation.

C. FRC Placement Specialist

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FRC Placement Specialist will manage the Family Unit mailbox for FRC placement requests. FRC Placement Specialist will be the primary point of contact for FRC placement requests from docket officers who have determined that family unit is eligible for FRC placement. If eligible, docket officer will be required to provide FRC Placement Specialist with the required documentation for FRC placement. If approved for placement, FRC Placement Specialist will coordinate movement of family units with stakeholders. FRC Placement Specialist will ensure that stakeholders are aware of family unit transfers and that (b)(7)(E) comments and detention records are updated accordingly. FRC Placement Specialist will generate email correspondence, notifications, tallies, records, and reports for all FRC placement requests to be submitted to the NDP Intake/Placement Coordinator for daily reporting and consolidation.

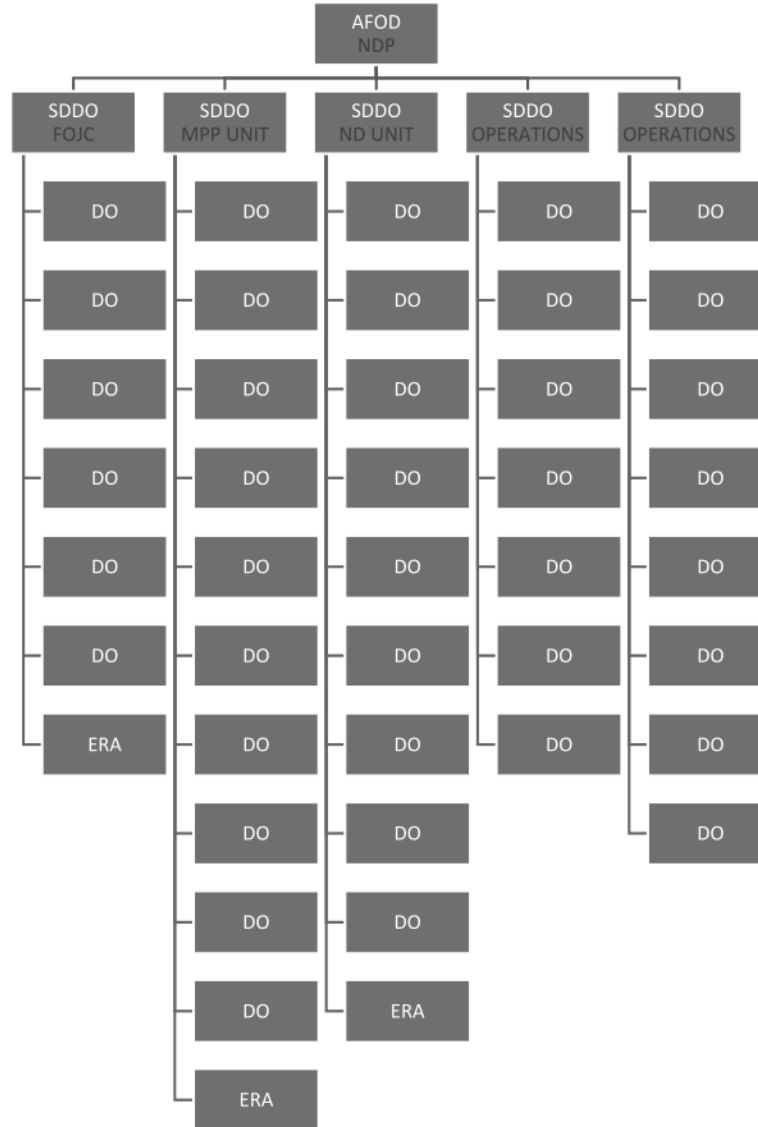
D. Operations

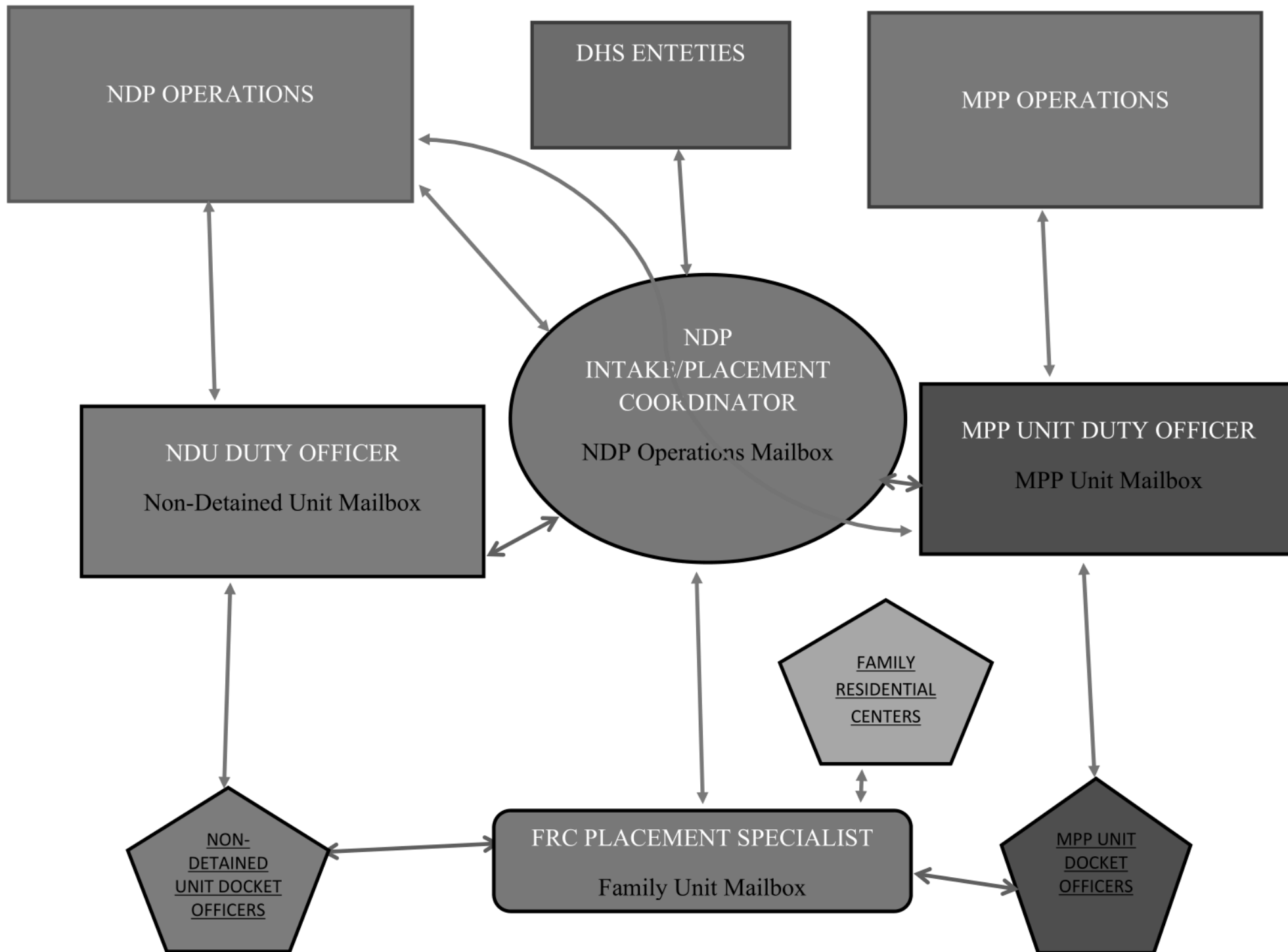
Officers assigned to operations pick up manifests and release packets from the NDP Intake/Placement Coordinator for daily service at Station One. At Station One, officers review immigration files for accuracy and works with CBP staff to facilitate corrections when needed. Officers will interview individuals to check for medical issues or address any other concerns prior to transferring custody to the transportation contractor. Officers will serve Parole/OREC/OSUP on subjects, obtaining all necessary photos, prints, and signatures. Officers will ensure transportation and release counts are verified and any add-ons or no shows are documented for reporting to the Non-Detained/MPP unit duty officers (who will in turn report the information to the NDP Intake/Placement Coordinator). Officers will sort files and deliver files to the appropriate docket officer. Release packets for no shows will be returned to the Non-Detained Unit duty officer or the MPP Unit duty officer for follow-up or future scheduling. Officers will ensure that confirmed releases are booked out daily and case comments updated. Detention records and (b)(7)(E) case comments will be updated for no shows and/or add-ons. Officers may be required to coordinate transportation or temporary housing for NDP releases, transfers, or removals or assist in processing releases when needed.

Officers may be assigned to conduct MPP operations (Monday-Friday). Officers assigned to MPP operations generate (b)(7)(E) manifests and coordinate transportation for MPP court. MPP operational staff serve as a liaison between ICE, EOIR, CBP, OPLA and other stakeholders to address issues or specific concerns with regards to the MPP Program. Officers collect MPP data and provide daily reporting to the MPP Unit duty officer for the MPP Report and Outlook Calendar. Officers will ensure that MPP detention records and (b)(7)(E) case comments are updated accordingly.

Did you guys confirm if family was in fact paroled? Its my understanding that family presented themselves at the port of entry on December 16 and they were remanded to your custody without parole. I don't think they've ever been to court. I asked OFO to check their records to see if family has ever been paroled for MPP court. I'm starting to doubt that they were even ever paroled at all because there is no record on the government attorney notes for the December 5th court date. I'm also having to doubt that the IJ order is valid and may possibly be issued in error as NTAs May have never been filed. Knowing whether or not family was paroled or when they were paroled will be critical when drafting the NTA especially if BP is moving on an assumption that family was paroled. The question I posed ICE OPLA here in El Paso was asking if family should be considered applicants for admission. The OPLA chief is out and I will have to follow-

up with him on the question when he gets back. Do you know if you will be referring these cases to us for release or is BP direct releasing?

At that time, it was discovered that MPP family had their removal proceedings terminated and OFO remanded family to BP's custody. Can you check your records to find out if the family was ever paroled for MPP court? Do you have any records of families' return(s) to Mexico since their arrest on 09/08/19? Below is a case timeline. Any information you can provide will be very helpful to determine if family is amenable to expedited removal or not

09/08/19 - MPP family unit (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) arrested by BP making illegal entry at or near Presidio, TX. Family unit was processed for MPP and returned to Mexico with an initial hearing scheduled for 12/05/19

09/13/19 - NTAs filed with MPP court as per EOIR information tab in (b)(7)(E)

10/21/19 - (b)(5)

12/05/19 - PLANet indicates hearing on 12/05/19 with (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) present for the government. There are no case notes to indicate if family was present in court.

This family is no longer MPP. IJ terminated proceedings on December 5, 2019. MPP removal case has been closed for (b)(7)(E). On December 18, 2019, ICE ERO MPP staff informed BP that family will have to be re-processed with a new event. BP has not processed these cases with new event numbers. BP instead used the (b)(7)(E) to issue a new charging document (Form I-871) to father. It doesn't appear that family qualifies to be re-enrolled for MPP due to language

barrier. CBP can either proceed with PACR (if the family claims fear) or ER if family does not claim fear and process them for ENV. Regardless how CBP wants to proceed, CBP will have to create a new event and re-issue new charging documents under the new event number. - ERO/OCC will verify if order has been issued. If so, copy will be provided to CBP to serve to the subject(s)
- Once the individual/FAMU is served with the order, CBP will issue a new tear sheet and return subject(s) to Mexico with instructions to report in 31 days
- The day that the MPP individual/FAMU reports after the 30 days, ERO/OCC will confirm if an appeal was filed
 - If **no** appeal filed, individual/FAMU is a final order and CBP should move forward with removal requests via ENV or ERO detention
 - If appeal is filed, the order is not final and CBP should issue a tear sheet for another 45 days to check for the BIA decision
- Additional tear sheets will be issued by CBP as needed pending the appeal with the BIA
- If the individual/FAMU fail to return after the 31 days, or report at a later time, or are apprehended again after the 31 days
 - If **no** appeal was filed, the individual/FAMU is a final order and should be treated as a "bag and baggage"

If the appeal was filed and is still pending, the individual/FAMU should be returned to Mexico with a new tear sheet as they are still under the MPP proceedings. Note: CBP will refer MPP individual(s) to USCIS for non-refoulment interview if individual expresses fear of returning to Mexico
